Behaviour and confidentiality Policy

As a member of the Board of Directors of SportCheer Wales, I have a legal and ethical responsibility to ensure that the organisation does the best work possible in pursuit of its goals. I support the purpose and mission of the organisation and pledge my commitment to assist in carrying out its work.

As a board member, I will consistently act responsibly and prudently. I understand my duties to include:

1. Legal and moral responsibility, along with my fellow board members, for the well-being of this organisation. As such, it is my responsibility to:

- Know and approve all policies and programs and oversee their implementation.
- Take responsibility for making decisions on organisation issues and board matters.
- Interpret the organisation's work and values to the community and represent the organisation in a positive way.
- Serve as a supportive spokesperson where required
- Keep up-to-date on the business of the organisation.
- Excuse myself from discussions, decisions and votes where I may have a conflict of interest.
- Not personally profit from the organisation in any way.
- Maintain the privacy and confidentiality of all board meetings, not releasing information prior to announcements by SportCheer Wales directly
- Not discuss details of any plans, projects or concerns with anyone outside of the National Board, unless approved by the board members.

2. Attendance at 6 board meetings per year. Should I be unable to attend a meeting, I will, if needed, be available for telephone consultation. Additionally, I will serve on at least one board committee.

4. Active participation in one or more fundraising activities. This may include individual and/or special event solicitation or direct mail appeals.

5. Working in good faith with my fellow board members and staff toward the achievement of the organisation's goals.

Should I fail to fulfil these commitments to the organisation, I understand that the Board President will call upon me to discuss my responsibilities. Should there come a time where I am no longer able to fulfil my obligations to the organisation, it will be my responsibility to resign my position as a member of the Board of Directors.
