



SPORT CHEER WALES

Team Wales Representation Agreement.

Terms of Selection

1. Any interested Welsh Cheerleading teams are eligible to apply for junior team representation
2. Decisions on representatives will be made by the SportCheer Wales National Body
3. Where this indicates a conflict of interest, a selected panel of judges will be convened to judge routines and decide on representatives (if any)
4. There is no guarantee that an application will lead to an offer to represent Wales at ICU worlds
5. All Team members must be of junior age during the year of competition
6. All teams are responsible for the payment and administration of their own travel and ticket arrangements
7. No financial support can be given by the SportCheer Wales National Body to subsidise athletes or programmes.
8. Coaches of applicant teams must be qualified to an appropriate level in the discipline for which an application has been made.
9. Applicant teams should be scheduled to remain in Florida for the duration of the International Cheer Union competition including opening and closing ceremonies.
10. No announcements regarding application status can be made by the team prior to SportCheer Wales announcements being released.

Terms of Representation

1. Any chosen cheer teams must perform in Team Wales uniform and bows
2. Any chosen Team Freestyle pom teams must perform in Team Wales uniform
3. Any chosen Team Jazz and Hip Hop teams must perform in suitable uniforms agreed by the SCW national body.
4. Chosen teams should showcase routines at a regional competition or event which the SCW national body should attend at least one month before the International Cheer Union World Championships.

Terms of Representation continued.

5. All athletes and coaches should take part in the opening and closing ceremonies in full Team Wales warm up kit.
6. The SportCheer Wales and Team Wales Cheer and Dance logos, name and brand may not be displayed, altered or used by representing programmes without prior approval by the SportCheer Wales National Body.
7. All appropriate music licensing and associated paperwork should be obtained by the representative programme prior to team competition entry being made.
8. Selected teams may not advertise themselves as 'Team Wales' but may advertise themselves as 'programme name – Team Wales representatives.'
9. Coaches of selected team are not considered 'Team Wales coaches' and may not represent or advertise themselves as such.
10. Coaches of selected teams may not challenge judging or official decisions at the International Cheer Union World Championships without prior authorisation from the national body.
11. Athletes and Coaches must sign the Team Wales code of practice prior to an offer being made by the SportCheer Wales National Body.
12. Any sponsorship items or arrangements may not be requested on behalf of Team Wales without prior authorisation from the SportCheer Wales National Body.
