

## Club Covid-19 Officer

As part of the Welsh Government return to sport and leisure guidance, organisations and clubs have been asked to nominate a Covid 19 Officer.

The Covid - 19 Officer will be a key resource for clubs in all matters of Covid-19 and ensuring a safe environment for cheerleading activity. They will promote clear and effective communication channels to ensure all members feel supported and have someone to go to should they have any questions or concerns.

The SportCheer Wales Covid-19 Officer is Victoria Jenkins (Secretary)

The responsibilities will include:

- To act as a main point of contact for all members with regards to Covid-19
- To oversee the implementation of the relevant risk assessments
- To keep up to date with the latest Government advice and guidelines on Covid-19
- To regularly review the clubs risk assessments and safety documents and recommend changes when necessary.
- To support the Directors, Welfare Officer and/or coaches with any related Covid-19 issues.
- Liaise with the SportCheer Wales Covid - 19 officer
